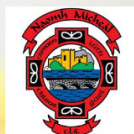

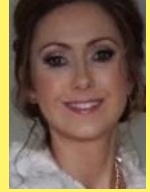

Ground Regulations

01. All persons entering this ground are admitted only subject to the following Ground Regulations and to the Rules and regulations of Cumann Luthchleas Gael. Entry to the ground shall be deemed to constitute unqualified acceptance of all these Rules and Regulations.

02. Fireworks, smoke canisters, gas-horns, bottles, glasses, cans, flags, banners, poles and other similar articles or containers, including anything which could or might be used as a weapon, are not permitted within the ground and any person in found to be in possession of such an article or container may be refused entry or ejected from the ground

03. The consumption of alcohol is not permitted within the ground and spectators are not permitted to bring alcohol into the ground.

04. The unauthorized climbing of any structure, walls or buildings in this ground strictly forbidden.

05. Unnecessary noise from the use of radio sets, gas-horns and behaviour likely to cause confusion or nuisance of any kind, including foul or abusive language, is not permitted in any part of the ground.

06. Under no circumstances is it permitted to

throw any object the pitch.

07. Unauthorised persons are not permitted to enter upon the field of play.

08. Any person who fails to comply with the instruction from a Garda or Steward may be ejected from the ground.

09. In general, the right of admission is reserved to the Ground Management.

10. The Ground Management reserves the right to refuse admission to or eject any person who refuses to be searched by a member of the Garda Síochána.

11. Any person who remains in or obstructs a gangway or circulation area may be ejected from the ground.

12. The Ground Management reserve the right for it's servants or agents to remove from the ground any person who does not comply with the Ground Regulations or whose presence in the ground could reasonably be construed as constituting a source of danger, nuisance or annoyance to other spectators.

13. All persons in the grounds are reminded of their obligation under Section 18(3) of the Fire Services Act 1981 to ensure that their behaviour does not present a danger from fire to anyone using the grounds.

OFFICIAL GAA PLAYING RULES CHANGES 2021

DENYING A GOAL SCORING OPPORTUNITY: HURLING

(Senior Inter-County only)

If any of the following infractions are committed, on an attacking player with a goal-scoring opportunity, either inside the 20-metre line or the semi-circular arc.

- (a) To pull down an opponent or
- (b) To trip an opponent with hands, arm, leg, foot, or hurley or
- (c) To use the hurley in a careless manner

the following penalties shall apply -

- (i) A penalty puck shall be awarded to the team affected.
- (ii) Additional to being issued a caution (yellow card), the offender shall be sent to the sin bin for 10 minutes.

Exception: If the infraction is a second cautionable infraction, the offender shall be ordered off for the remainder of the game, including extra-time when played.



TEMPORARY SUBSTITUTION:

A player who sustains a suspected head injury, if instructed by the referee, shall temporarily leave the field of play for further assessment before the player's fitness to return is determined.



ADVANTAGE RULE FOOTBALL & HURLING

When an aggressive foul is committed, the referee may allow the play to continue if he considers that this presents the potential of a goal-scoring opportunity or another advantage to the team offended by creating or capitalising on time and space.

He shall signal that advantage by raising an arm upright and shall allow the advantage to run by maintaining his arm in the upright position for up to five seconds after the foul or for less time if it becomes clear that no advantage has accrued.

If he deems no advantage to have accrued, he may subsequently award a free for the foul from where it occurred, except as provided under exceptions (v) and (vi) of Rule 2.2.

He shall apply any relevant disciplinary action.



INTERFERING WITH A KICK/PUCK OUT

It's now a foul to interfere with a goalkeeper by jumping up and down, waving hands or hurley, or any other physical or verbal interference considered by the referee to be aimed at distracting the player taking the kick/puck out.



MISCONDUCT AT GAMES BY TEAM OFFICIALS

(Inter-County only)

Yellow cards can now be issued to team officials for the following infractions.

- To make an unauthorised incursion onto the field of play.
- To challenge the authority of a referee, umpire, linesman or sideline official.
- To threaten or to use abusive or provocative language or gestures to an opposing player or team official.
- To threaten or to use abusive or provocative language or gestures to a player of own team.

The following changes were made to the rules around misconduct at games by team officials and the introduction of the issuing of yellow & red cards and match suspensions in place of term suspensions for several infractions.

Red cards can now be issued to team officials for the following infractions.

- To use abusive language to a referee, umpire, linesman or sideline official.
- To engage in disruptive conduct.
- Any type of physical interference with an opposing player or team official.
- To interfere with the playing of the game.
- Minor physical interference with (e.g. laying a hand on, pushing, pulling or jostling), threatening or abusive conduct towards, or threatening language to, a referee, umpire, linesman or sideline official.
- Any type of assault on a referee, umpire, linesman or sideline official.

Semi-final pairs Renew Recent Rivalries - Chris McNulty (Donegal Democrat)

THE 2021 Donegal SFC semi-final pairings have thrown up repeat encounters from the recent past. In back-to-back semi-finals in 2015 and 2016 there were winning margins of 12 points and 11 points when Naomh Conaill and Kilcar crossed swords. Naomh Conaill had an emphatic 4-10 to 0-10 win in 2015, but the chart was flipped a year later, Kilcar winning 5-10 to 1-11. Kilcar ended a 24-year wait for Dr Maguire in 2017 when they overcame Naomh Conaill 0-7 to 0-4 in the final.

Naomh Conaill toppled Gaoth Dobhair impressively last weekend, Jeaic Mac Cealabhú's goal key in a 1-10 to 0-8 win to tee up a semi-final joust with Kilcar that will need no added spice following their recent encounters on and off the field. "We have a big test next weekend and it's about getting the bodies right," Mac Cealabhú assessed. We managed the game well and we saw it out well at the end."

Kilcar strolled into the last four via a 1-17 to 0-2 win over Sean MacCumhailis and it has been a trouble free Championship for the Towney men. So far: "The goal was just to get the job done and move forward," Mark McHugh said last weekend.

St Eunan's and St Michael's also have plen-

ty of semi-final previous. It is ten years now since St Michael's were beaten by Glenswilly in their only previous appearance in a SFC final, in 2011.

Five years beforehand, St Eunan's - thanks to a goal by Ross Wherity - squeezed past St Michael's into the 2006 decider. In 2014, a Darragh Mulgrew goal was vital as St Eunan's edged St Michael's 1-12 to 2-8 also in a semi. St Michael's dared to dream when goals by Brian McLaughlin and Andrew Kelly had them 2-3 to 0-7 in front, but Mulgrew turned the tide. A year later, St Eunan's were convincing 2-16 to 0-7 winners over St Michael's in a more one-sided semi-final. "We have bad memories from that night," says St Michael's captain Liam Paul Ferry. "A good few young lads have stepped in for us this year and they pick up the slack."

Rory Kavanagh played for St Eunan's against St Michael's in each of their previous semi-final tussles. Now the St Eunan's manager, says his team has to show improvement. "Work to do, but maybe it's good to have work to do going into a semi-final.

"There have been a few occasions when teams came back with a goal, but our reaction has been good."
