In Glenties, on Sunday July 9th, just like Carrick-on-Shannon the previous night, a last minute goal brought this game to extra-time. However, there the similarities end as Kilcar took full advantage of their late strike from Cormac Cannon, to finish off St. Nauls in extra-time.

St. Nauls seemed to be on their way to the title when they led 1-2 to 0-2 at half-time and they stretched that lead to five points with six minutes of normal time left.

Kilcar started well with points from Conor Doherty and James Carr inside ten minutes but then St. Nauls hit back with a Jamie Coyle free and on 26 minutes Coyle goaled from the penalty spot after Stephen Meehan was fouled. That was one of the turning points in the game as Kilcar felt they should have had a penalty minutes prior to the Nauls award.

Before half time Conor McDavitt added another point for St. Nauls. Christopher Doogan had an early second half point for Kilcar and Owen O'Donnell spurned a good goal chance.

Jamie Coyle created the opening for Stephen Meehan to hit a second Nauls goal on 49 minutes. Conor Doherty replied with a free but Daniel Brennan left five points in it again with six minutes left.

Kilcar finished well with Aidan McGinley and Conor Doherty pointing before Cormac Cannon got forward to level matters a minute into added time.

In extra time Kilcar took a grip of the tie with Andrew McClean and Conor Doherty pointing. Conor McDavitt replied but Doherty left two between the sides as they changed over.

St. Nauls's best player, Manus Darby, came forward to leave the minimum between the sides two minutes into the second period but Kilcar finished strongly with Aidan McGinley (free) and Conor Doherty closing out the tie. Young Doherty, who is still under 10, was my man of the match, a real intelligent livewire at full-forward.

They were also well served by Andrew McClean, Cormac Cannon, Stephen McBrearty and Rachel McHugh (daughter of Martin and also under 10), while the introduction of Aidan McGinley at half-time gave them impetus. McGinley was not risked in the first half as he had a recent appendicitis operation. St. Nauls had good displays from Manus Darby, 'keeper Dylan Furry, Kenny McDaid, Jamie Coyle, James McGowan and Conor McDavitt.

In a very close encounter Kilcar added the U-14 Championship title to their league trophy when they came from behind to overcome a gallant Naomh Ultan side in Tirconaill Park, Donegal Town on Sat Nov 3rd 2007. Kilcar were the better side in the opening half but only had a one point advantage at the break, 2-5 to 2-4.

A well taken goal from Stephen McBrearty had Kilcar 1-3 to 0-2 ahead after ten minutes but Alan Lyons hit back with a goal for the Dunkineely men. And when Kevin Gallagher got a second Kilcar goal, Lyons again responded with a second in a very good first half display that saw him hit 2-2. Kilcar did have a number of goal chances with Patrick McBrearty going close on a couple of occasions.

The game changed in the opening minutes of the second half when Kilcar amazingly started with McBrearty at full-forward. Naomh Ultan took advantage hitting 1-3 in three minutes, Alan Lyons hitting a third goal and Cian Kennedy chipping in with two points.

But Kilcar moved McBrearty back to the middle and slowly they chipped away at the five point lead with McBrearty (3) and Matthew McClean pointing.

Cian Kennedy made it a two point game with ten minutes left but McClean and McBrearty points had Kilcar level with five minutes left.

Kevin Gallagher put them in front and Patrick McBrearty added the insurance point. Naomh Ultan kept trying and did have a chance in added time but they had to go for goal and the effort was blocked.

Apart from Patrick McBrearty, Kilcar had good performances from Ciaran O'Donnell, Stephen McBrearty, Matthew McClean and Kevin Gallagher. Alan Lyons was outstanding for the losers, as was Cian Kennedy but the Dunkineely men just relied too heavily on that duo.
