JOE CURRAN: Back. 23 years. 5'10". 12 st. E.S.B. employee. Has won Ulster Colleges medal at u-15 and u-17 with D.L.S. Ballyshannon, and u-12, u-14, u-16, u-18 and u-21 medals.

TOMMY McDERMOTT: Back. 25 years. 5'11". 12 st. Draughtsman. Captained the team to Championship victory last year. Won Ulster and All-Ireland Colleges medals with D.L.S. Ballyshannon.

PAURIC DALY: Back. 29 years. 5'9". 12 st. Teacher. Won his first senior championship medal last year.

CONOR BOYLE: Back. 22 years. 5'11". 13 st. Garda. Has won Ulster and All-Ireland Colleges medals with D.L.S. Ballyshannon.

Aodh Ruadh are the current County Senior Football Champions. They beat Red Hughs in the County final last year by 1-8 to 0-5 on Sunday August 24 in Ballybofey. They have won the senior championship on eight occasions in 1929, 1932, 1937, 1939, 1942, 1943, 1951, 1986 and also when amalgamated with Bundoran formed part of the great St. Joseph's team that won the title in 1965, 1966, 1968, 1970, 1973, 1974, 1975 and 1976. One of their many star players Dermott Keon — son of club chairman John — won an All-Ireland under 21 championship medal with Donegal this year and another, Brian Tuohy, has the distinction of being the first player ever to captain a Donegal county team to an All-Ireland title when he led the Under 21 to that memorable and historic All-Ireland victory in 1982. Their manager is P.J. Buggy with Michael McLoone assisting.

Kilcar, the challengers and former champions beat Four Masters by 0-9 to 0-7 in the 1985 senior final. They have won two other senior county football championships in 1925 and 1980. Many of their players are going for their third county championship today having played in 1980 and 1985 finals. Kilcar done themselves and Donegal proud earlier this year when they won the All-Ireland Gaeltacht senior championship for the first time in their history. They won four county league titles in a row from 1981 to 1984. Martin McHugh and Michael Carr have won Railway Cup medals representing the Province and McHugh is one of only three Donegal players to have been selected as an All-Star.
