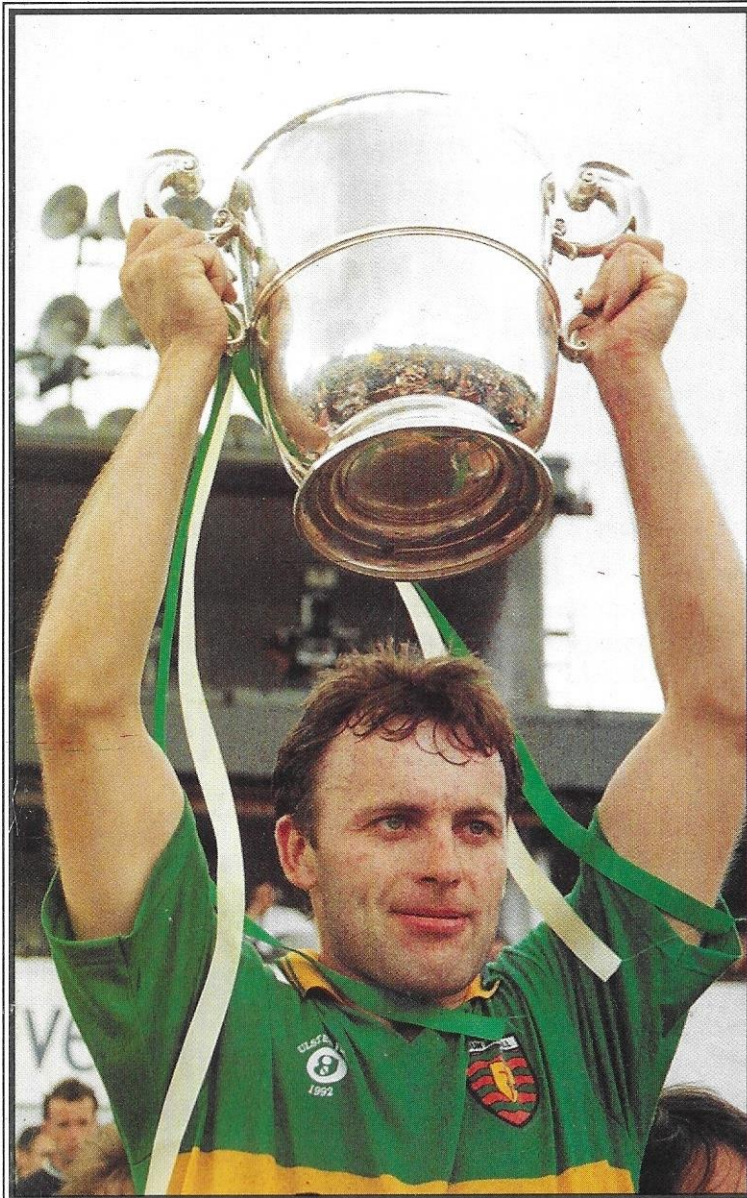

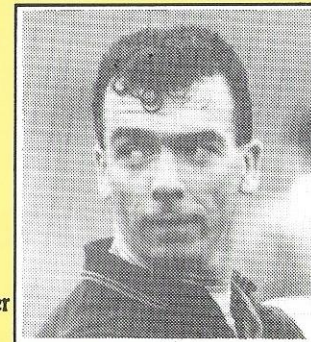

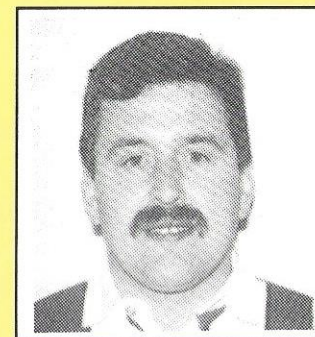

# A LONG WAIT

Antrim Captain Ciaran Hamill is in danger of being upstaged by his younger brother, Ronan. Earlier this season Ronan captained St. Colmans College, Newry to both MacRory and Hogan Cup success. In addition he captured the inaugural Iggy Jones Memorial Trophy after being named Man of the Match in the MacRory Cup Final.

This afternoon the younger Hamill will be a reluctant spectator at Ballybofey as he's over age for the County Minors. Ciaran Hamill though will be a key figure as Antrim bid to end a depressing run of championship defeats. One has to go back to 1982 for their last championship win against Cavan in Breffni Park. Dual star Donal Armstrong who lines out at left half forward this afternoon is the only survivor, but Ciaran Hamill actually played in the Minor game that same day.

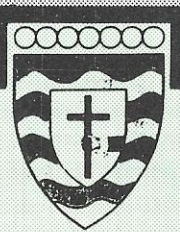
Six years ago Antrim drew with Tyrone in the championship opener at Casement Park. Ten minutes from the end they were five point clear, but then had Eddie McToal sent off and had to settle for a replay.

Tyrone won the replay and Antrim were left to reflect on what might have been. Two years later they were the authors of their own destruction at Casement Park. They outplayed Monaghan, but in the process they shot a staggering 22 wides and ultimately it cost them a semi-final place.

Stephen Mulvenna's appearance in a Derry jersey last Sunday at Newry epitomises some of the problems facing Antrim. In addition to Mulvenna they lost two other quality players in recent times Stephen Muldoon and Stephen Faulkner placing an intolerable burden on their already limited resources.

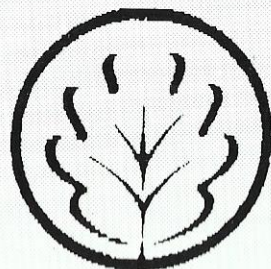

## SIDELINES BY ADRIAN LOGAN OF UTV

As Donegal prepare to take on Antrim, one of their former stars in preparing to make his championship debut for Sligo in London. Brian Tuohy, who captained Donegal to the All-Ireland U-21 Title in 1982, played his last game for his native county in the League defeat by Dublin at Breffni Park last season.

Antrim, who give championship debuts this afternoon to five players, are quoted as 50 to 1 outsiders for the Ulster Title - while All-Ireland Champions Donegal, still on offer at 5-2, have been displaced as favourites by Derry who are 6-4.

In recent time goals have become common place in the Championship - this year is no exception. This season to date 17 goals have been scored in the Senior Championship. Out on top are Armagh who've hit five goals in their two games so far.

The Antrim team can claim a slice of All-Ireland Glory already. Ciaran Hamill's younger brother Ronan was the captain of the St. Colman's Hogan Cup side.

They're a holy lot this Antrim squad. In all 21 players on the team come from saintly clubs - St. Paul's, St. Joseph's, St. John's and St. Gall's. And it doesn't stop there - more on the bench including Enda McAtamney who play for - All Saints.

## ULSTER POC FADA SEMI-FINAL

At half-time in the Senior game the Ulster Poc Fada Semi-Final takes place. Counties taking part are : Antrim, Cavan, Donegal, Fermanagh, Tyrone.

### RULES FOR THE POC FADA COMPETITION

1. Each competitor will be allowed three strokes and these should be taken from the centre point on the 20 metre line.
2. The ball must be kept within the pitch area on both sides. Any ball going over the sideline will be considered a Poc but not be marked.
3. If a competitor fails to strike the ball, this will be counted as a Poc.
4. The sliotar must be struck from out of the hand.
5. All competitors must be under 14 years on the 1st January, 1993.
6. The length of the Poc will be judged from the 20 metre line to where the sliotar dies.
7. All shots should be measured where there is a doubt.
8. Trophies will be provided for all winners at the various stages
  - County
  - Provincial
  - All-Ireland
9. The sliotar used in the competition must be a leather one.

## Gap hard to bridge for Antrim

It's eleven years since Antrim have tasted Ulster success at Minor level and their recent history in the competition has been less than fruitful.

In the same period Donegal have had their most successful period at the U-18 age group, winning the Minor League in 1982, 1984 and 1985, while winning Ulster Championships in 1985 and 1991. They also reached last year's Ulster final as the fruits of good work at underage level over the years came to fruition.

Why Antrim have not had success is difficult to explain as they have the benefit of the biggest centre of population in the province where the talent should be easy enough to harness.

The Saffrons have yet to win a game this year at the grade as they lost all their Minor League games and challenges and this team assembled by mentors - Tommy Hall as manager, Brian Coyle, Ray McEvoy, Seamus Hassan, Eddie McKeever and Maurice Ashe - are mostly inexperienced 17 year olds. The panel lost 6 or 7 of their best players earlier in the season because the A-Level exams coincide with today's match - a perennial problem for talented footballers, whether to risk injury and the consequent possible loss of a full year's study.

Goalkeeper and captain, Donal Shannon from Gleneavy is the only survivor from last year's team defeated by Fermanagh in the first round. They will also be relying on St. Colman's MacRory Cup star, Ronan Hamill; full-back Aaron Cushley, Damien Bannon, Paul Grogan and talented youngster, Adrian Gallagher for big performances.

On the other side of the coin Donegal have not been setting the world on fire either. New manager, Denis Ellis, along with trainer, Eamonn Harvey, will almost certainly be pinning his hopes on most of the squad which brought him his managerial breakthrough in the U-16 Ted Webb Competition two years ago.

David Clarke and Barry Ward are the only Donegal panelists from last year's beaten Ulster Finalists. But there are major doubts about the participation of both. Clarke, a Cadet trainee in the Curragh may not be released, while Ward picked up a serious back injury in a challenge last weekend. Others to watch out for today are St. Jarlath's player, Eamonn Haran, Shane Carr at midfield, Shane McClafferty (son of ex-county player, Hughie) and Pauric Gillespie, a famous name from the Naomh Columba club.

Antrim mentor, Brian Coyle, of St. Pauls, points to the lack of any real College success as being the main part of Antrim's problems. They have only one College - St. Mary's - competing at MacRory Cup level, and they are nearly always knocked out in the first round.

The Antrim mentors would also point to the lack of any real backing for the County Minors by the Co. Board - something which was reflected in difficulty even in the basic organising of training sessions. But then again it isn't easy raising the finance necessary without some success. Despite reaching the All-Ireland B Final late in 1992 the Antrim Senior team don't have a sponsor.

While Donegal Minor mentors of the past few years have had their brushes with the Co. Board, by and large they have been well looked after.

It is 23 years since the Antrim Senior team contested an Ulster Final and you have to go back to 1951 for the last Ulster Senior success. Donegal have proved in the last twenty years that if the Minors are looked after that Senior success will follow and there must be a lesson there for Antrim.
