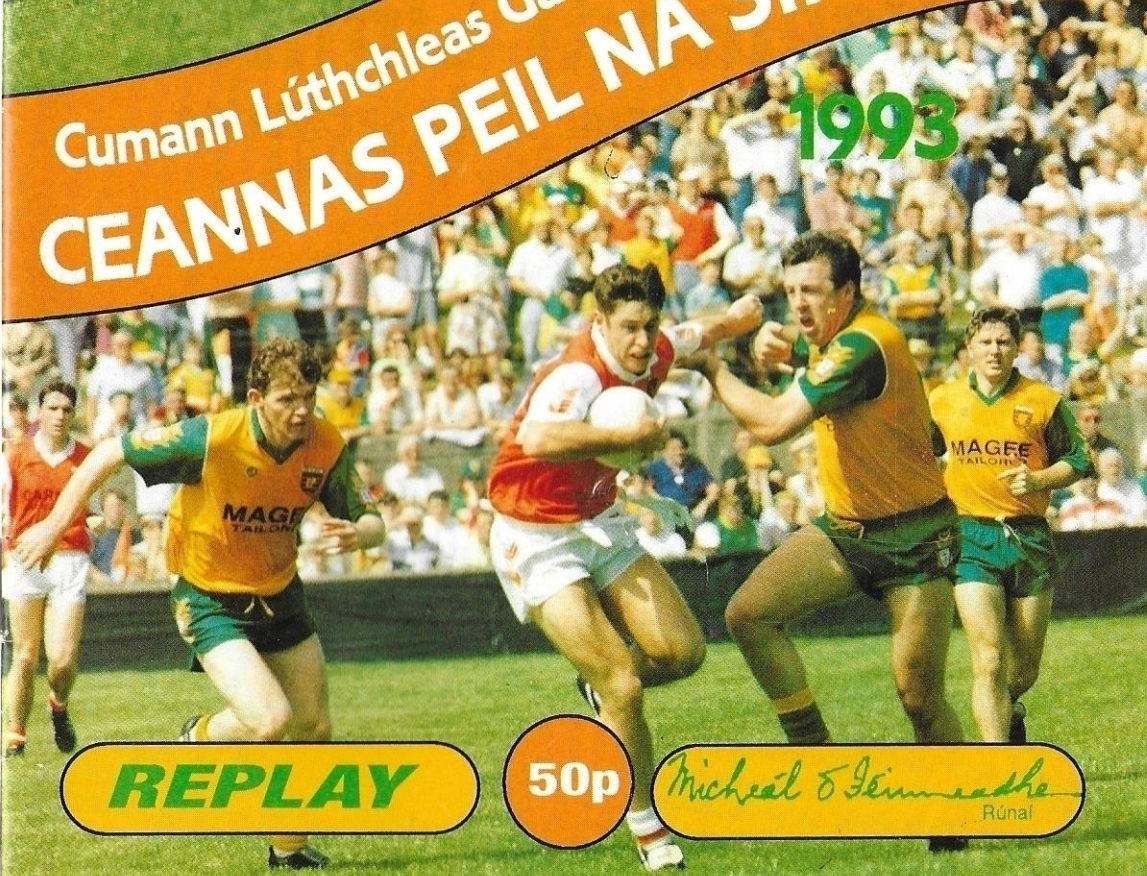

## **Breffni Extravaganza**

It is a long way from the streets of London to the Hills of Breffni, but last Sunday a 23 year old novice made the transition with the greatest of ease.

It says much for John Duffy's confidence and temperament that he was able to wield such influence after coming on midway through the second half and but for his two priceless late points All Ireland Champions Donegal would this afternoon be reflecting on past glories.

Instead they are back in Breffni Park this afternoon determined to hang onto both their Provincial and All Ireland titles. For John Duffy, once described as the next Martin McHugh, it's an opportunity to enhance still further his growing reputation.

Who could believe that only 12 months ago the young emerging Duffy was playing his club football in the English capital with Tir Conaill Gaels? Later that same season he was to wear the London colours in the Connacht Championship.

Last Sunday's drawn game was only Duffy's second senior outing in the Donegal jersey, his debut being the Royal Silver League clash with Longford last March. His confidence and composure on the ball was remarkable for a player making his Ulster Championship debut in the most demanding and searching circumstances.

On a day when most other civil servants were absent from the work place, two players from the Civil Service club in Dublin, John Duffy and Michael Gallagher were very much instrumental in reviving Donegal's fading championship aspirations against all the odds.

If a week is along time in politics, it's even more significant in sport. By this afternoon both Armagh and Donegal having licked their wounds, will be ready to conjure up another Breffni extravaganza.

Ón lá sin go dtí an lá inniu, tá 69 cluiche imriste ag Tír Chonaill sa Chraobh agus san Sraith Náisiúnta Peile. Is é Gary an t'aon imreoir a d'imir in gach cluiche acu sin. Bhí an chead chluiche san ré órga sin i gcoinne Chill Dara. I gcúrsaí Straithe, d'imir fear Bhéal Átha Scanaigh 49 cluiche – ina measc aon chluiche dhéag sraithe in 1992-93. Tá fiche cluiche Craoibhe imriste aige as a chéile, chomh maith le ceithre chluiche Craoibhe eile ag tús na n-ochtóidí.

Mar sin inniu, tá an réaltóg Gary Walsh ag imirt a Sheachtó cluiche as a Chéile da chontae. Éacht nach bhfuil agus creidim nach mbeidh sáraithe.
