



St. Eunans chase three-in-a-row

St. Eunans (Letterkenny) will put their minor championship crown on the line on Sunday in Ballybofey (2 p.m.) when they meet Ardara for the second year in a row.

St. Eunans are seeking their third consecutive title while Ardara are aiming to lift the cup for the first time since 1981.

The Letterkenny side last put three minor titles back to back in 1972, '73 and 74, but on Sunday they will be up again an Ardara side which has twelve of last year's team in action.

Ardara booked their place in the final with a 1-11 to 2-6 win over Four Masters in the semi-final. On Monday night, St. Eunans recorded a one point win (1-7 to 1-6) over Ballyshannon in Ballybofey.

When the sides met last year in Tirconail Park, Donegal Town, St. Eunans emerged winners by five points.

They have five of last year's team this time round and team manager, Noel Cassidy, will be looking to senior players, Kevin Winston, David McGinley, Shane O'Donnell and Paul O'Dowd to lead the way.

Team manager, Noel Cassidy and trainer, Dickie McGranaghan have worked hard with this young side, nine of whom will be eligible next year.

"In many ways we are in the same position as Ardara were in last year. We had an exceptionally good side last year and with so many available against next year Ardara will start as favourites this time round" Cassidy said.

"Having said that there could only be a kick of the ball between the sides. If we hit top form we will give them a run for their money", he added.

Ardara manager, Pat O'Donnell, feels it is time the trophy came back to the town. "The last time we won the title was 1981. I feel we have a better all round side than last year and we are aiming to get it right this time," he said.

They will look to senior players, Conal Doherty, ace free taker, Jonathan Boyle, to lead the way on Sunday along with John and Aodh Brennan, and Peter McHugh.

Ardara are favourites which will suit St. Eunans and a good final is in store.





Seamie Granaghan — "a captain's part" in 1970

Today the County champions of 1970 will be honoured as part of the now traditional tribute to the team who won the Dr. Maguire Cup 25 years ago.

That team, St. Joseph's of Bundoran and Ballyshannon won the title at today's venue with a rather facile victory over Rosses Rovers, by 1-16 to 0-4.

The captain was flying half-forward Seamie Granaghan from Bundoran who, in the words of my father writing for the *Donegal Democrat* "played a true captain's part."

Wrote Hugh Daly: "It was fitting that this St. Joseph's side should be captained by the accomplished

Seamie Granaghan, who played a real captain's part in his rallying, distribution of the ball and scoring --- he scored six points of St. St. Joseph's total from play."

Two years later Granaghan was part of the history making Donegal team who won the Ulster Senior Championship for the first time. He was a tormentor of defences, small in stature but lighting quick and never afraid to shoot from distance.

A fellow Bundoran-man, Peter Quinn was described in that same Democrat report as "the star of the attack" scoring some five points. A goal after four minutes delivered by Pauric McShea to Mickey McLoone set the tone, McLoone crashing the ball past Naul McCole.

Elsewhere points flowed freely with St. Joseph's all but certain of winning what would prove their third county title of recent years with a 1-10 to 0-3 half-time lead.

Only once was Alan Kane, another to savour historic county success in '72 seriously questioned, making a fine save.

In the second half four players, two from each side were sent-off, apparently it was the first time in 145 games that Tyrone official Patsy Devlin had to send players to the line.

Following the game Paddy Hoey, Convoy presented the Dr. Maguire Cup to Seamie Granaghan amid scenes of delight captured in the accompanying photograph.

On their return to Ballyshannon celebrations through the town were silent due to a bereavement and the 80 cars moved through the Erne town in silence as a mark of respect following the death of Mr. Charles McHugh, father of the former Joseph's and county 'keeper, Sean McHugh.
