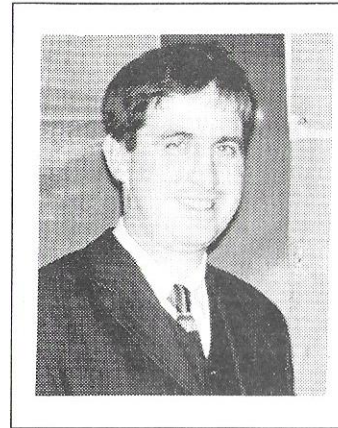

On behalf on Bord na Contae, I would like to welcome you all here to Mac Cumhaill Park today for Allianz NFL meeting of Donegal and Louth. We extend a special welcome to those from the 'wee' county, a team that we haven't crossed swords with too often in competitive fare. The term 'wee' may be appropriate in terms of the size of the county, but can no longer be used to describe the footballing worth of their squad who have improved year after year under the leadership of Paddy Clarke and can now be counted up with their more 'namely' neighbours in Leinster. From a Donegal point of view, it was encouraging to see a larger than normal support travel to Tuam for our last match and hopefully, it will steadily increase during the campaign to something like the support we enjoyed throughout most of the nineties.

So hopefully we will enjoy a good match today to end the year and thanks to all involved in any way in the arrangements for today's game

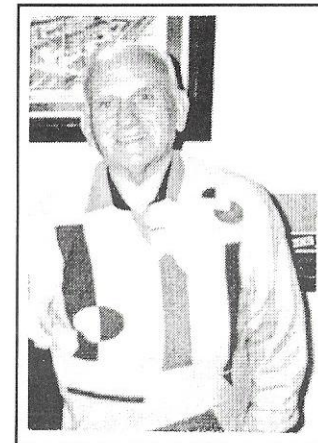

Chance for Revenge

The draw for the 2001 Ulster Championship was made two weeks ago and Donegal were given the chance to gain revenge over Fermanagh after the 'shock' defeat on June 11th last here in Ballybofey.

Donegal were the first team drawn from the 'hat' and so will have the advantage of having a home game against the Ernesiders, who were only narrowly beaten by eventual Ulster Champions Armagh in the semi-final.

The draw also gives Donegal their third home Championship match in a row, since the Championship draw became an annual open draw. Thankfully, the continued Development of our premier County Grounds, Mac Cumhaill Park, has allowed us to take advantage (if that is the right word) of the home draw, as other counties in Ulster are forced to take their championship matches to other venues.

Here's hoping that the progress shown in the two league games to date, under new manager, Mickey Moran and his team, can continue today and that Mac Cumhaill Park becomes a more difficult venue for visiting teams - come that 'Chance for Revenge' on May 13th next.

LOUTH IMPRESS

GERRY ROBINSON *reflects on a year when pride was
unanimously restored in Wee County football*

THE BAD NEWS FIRST: Once again, an agonising Championship exit at the semi-final stage was to be the Wee County's lot. Louth haven't contested a provincial final at senior level since 1960 and the spectre of this damning statistic continues to loom menacingly

AND THE GOOD NEWS: on the evidence of the heartening performance against neighbours Meath at Croke Park in late June, Paddy Clarke's team looks capable of re-writing the history books.

At last, Louth appear to have a side that can make a serious challenge for Leinster Championship honours. Make no mistake about it - Louth did not 'bottle it' in '98 as they have so often being accused of doing in the past. Often, they stood guilty as charged. But not on this occasion. This was arguably Louth's best Championship in decades. They put in a superb performance against Meath and had they enjoyed the rub of the green on the day, would undoubtedly have caused one of the upsets of the year by eliminating the Royals from contention. So near and yet so far for Louth. But they are getting there. The county's prolonged spell in the Championship wilderness is surely drawing to a close.

Seán Boylan knows well that he was fortunate to leave Croke Park on the evening of Sunday, 28th June with his aspirations for the year intact. Indeed, he would not have begrudged Louth a replay had the sides finished level as they almost did. The Meath boss admitted as much afterwards and was quick to note that he always expected a difficult game, paying tribute to the noble efforts of the Louthmen and naming them as a team for the future. Boylan is rarely wrong in such matters.

Louth matched Meath for most of the seventy minutes and the truth of the matter is that, but for a bit of inexperience, it is they and not the Royals who would have advanced to the provincial decider. Another year of 'ifs' and 'buts' then . . . but following this defeat, the atmosphere in the county was perceptibly different to that which had pervaded Louth GAA in the wake of the previous narrow losses.

Optimism has replaced pessimism. A swagger has returned to Louth football and heads are being held high again. There was an unprecedented buzz evident as all Louth supporters sensed the beginning of something good rather than the end.

Louth are taking one last long hard look around the interior of the doldrums as they prepare to exit for pastures new.

Pride has certainly been restored to Louth football. The task at hand now is to build upon the achievements of former years.
