50 YEARS ON ...

Today's clash between the Rebel County and Tir Conaill is just a few weeks short of the 50th anniversary of their first ever meeting in the National Football League semi-final in Croke Park on 6th April, 1952.

Cork were victorious that day on a scoreline of 3-3 to 0-7, but since then Donegal have got the upper hand winning seven times, while Cork have just one outright victory back in Ballincollig in 1990, a game remembered by Donegal fans who made the journey southwards on successive weekends after the initial game was called off at the last minute. The very first meeting back in 1952 is remembered fondly by Donegal gaels as they got a very rare chance to see their heroes play in Croke Park. The game was refereed by well-known RTE GAA man, Sean Og O Ceallachain.

INCONSISTENT CORK

Cork like Donegal have mixed the good with the bad in equal portion to date in this league campaign. After going under to Roscommon on opening day in Pairc Ui Caoimh their was little joy for Larry Tomkins in their next outing either. Westmeath who have become something of a bogey team for the Rebel county in recent times put them to the sword for a third consecutive time in twelve months.

And just when they were being written off as also rans and prime contenders for the trap door they travelled to Galway and pulled off a big result against the All Ireland champions on their own patch. A big scalp for Tomkins and co. at a time when confidence must surely have been flagging.

This win was followed by an even more impressive victory over Dublin down in Pairc Ui Caoimh, and all of a sudden the sun was shining on the banks of the Lee once more.

Four points out of a possible eight and without the Nemo Ranger's quartet of Colin Corkerry, Joe Kavanagh, Martin Cronin and Maurice McCarty things were certainly looking up.

And just when they found themselves well placed and back in the mix for a semi final spot they get caught napping by Offaly. While last Monday's defeat at the hands of the Faithful county does not rule out a place in the knock out stages it does make it a trifle more difficult. It would appear inconsistency in front of the post has cost the Leesiders dearly with a return of 4-51 from five outings.

Corner forward Philip Clifford who misses today's game following his red card on Monday is the teams top scorer with 1-14, Brendan Jer O Sullivan is in second place. The wing forward has helped himself to 2-7 with dual star Diarmuid O Sullivan posting 1-6 and Fionan Murray 0-9 are in joint third place.

Defensive frailties too, must be a concern for Cork supporters which has seen them concede 5-52 thus far. They will have to tighten up in this department this afternoon and again on Sunday next when they face Ulster champions Tyrone in Pairc Ui Caoimh if they are to entertain any hopes of making the last four and even at that they may have to rely on results elsewhere.

Many startled bed and breakfast owners reopened their doors to their faithful departed in green and gold later that ill-fated Sunday evening. "We've decided to stay on Mam, sure there'll be more comfort travelling in the morning," burped the forgotten troops.

Indeed, so keen was one Donegal businessman to make it back to the hills, that he booked a Sunday evening flight from Cork to Dublin in order to be at a meeting in the county the next morning. Alas, he too fell victim to the demon drink in the metropolis and didn't return home until that Wednesday by which time the majority of his brothers-in-arms had returned home.

In any case, we do hope this afternoon's fixture is a runner and should it fall victim to some unforeseen event, the rebel fans are welcome to spend a day or several in Donegal, sure Cork's only a wee spin down the road!

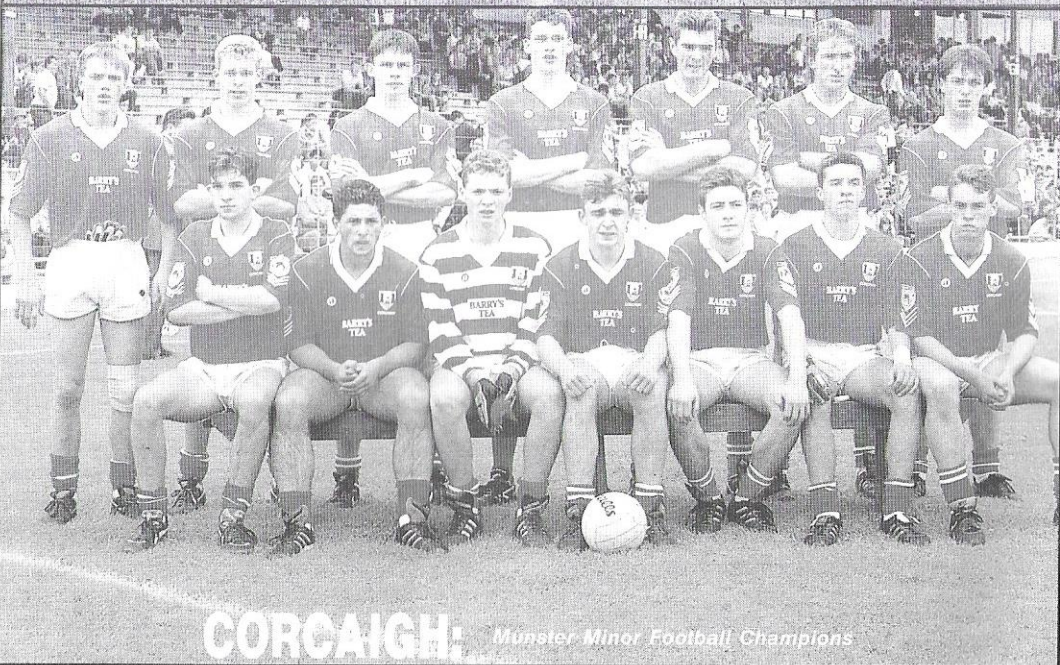

Remember 1991 . . .

Just over ten years ago Donegal and Cork met in the semi-final of the All-Ireland Minor Championship at Croke Park - the curtain raiser to Down and Kerry in the senior semi-final.

A very talented Donegal side lost out by three points - 1-6 to 0-12 - but what was most disappointing about the game was that only a handful of the Donegal side made it through to the senior side. A good number of the team were underage the following year, but lost out to Armagh at Ulster level, while some of them were involved when Donegal won the Ulster U-21 title in 1995, but lost out to Kerry in the All-Ireland semi-final.
