



- (b) The half time interval shall not exceed 10 minutes
- (c) Teams will be asked to line up for a team photograph, please do so immediately.
- 4. No Team Mascots or Children of Team Panel are allowed into the field.
- 5. A maximum number of three substitutes, without a ball, shall be allowed to warm up on the sideline at any one time and shall be confined to their own half of the field.
- 6. Upon the start of the game the subs, mentors and officials should return to the dugout and remain there during the course of the match.
- 7. All Managers and Medical Personnel are asked not to leave the dugouts during the course of the match unless absolutely necessary.
- 8. A kick around shall not be allowed at half time.
- 9. No videoing of the games are allowed unless with prior approval from the County Secretary.
- 10. Please comply with the instructions from the stewards.

A Coordinator will be appointed to each each and any breaches of these regulation will be dealt with very severely and incur a fine of 100 for each regulation breached.



He played with his native Malin picking up a junior championship medal in 1998 when he lined out at corner back. Currently living in Malin, Shaun is

Today's Junior "B" referee is Hugo Wallace from the Burt club. Aged 29, Hugo is one of a new generation of referees making significant strides in Donegal GAA. He has been refereeing at senior level for seven years now. He has all hurling medals from u-12 to senior with his native club and took charge of the junior hurling finals in 2003 and 2004 in Donegal.

Hugo's father, Austin was also a referee.

His three brothers have all represented Donegal in hurling with Andrew having also played for Ulster. Married to Rosemary and living in Newtowncunningham, Hugo hopes to take charge of a county senior football final at some stage in his career. He concedes that refereeing a hurling final may be a more difficult proposition in the near future!

We also knew that we needed the right man to lead us in the right direction, so we were glad at our AGM when Sean Bonner took on the job. I would also like to thank the 26 players on our panel who gave us a massive effort all year.

As for the final itself, we have already played Naomh Brid twice this year, they are a very good team and we know we will be up against it. The last time Na Rossa won the Junior Championship I was the mascot for the team so it would make me very proud to lift the same cup I sat in 25 years ago.

A word from the manager- Na Rossa.

2005 will go down as one of the worst years in Na Rossa history. The loss of key players, lack of commitment and very little training combined to see us finish bottom of division two.

Taking on job as manager this year I had mixed feelings. We had a lot of rebuilding to do to restore some pride in our club. At a players meeting in January we decided to give it 100% commitment with our main aims being promotion to Division Two and Junior Championship success. Training commenced in mid-January with good turnouts and after a number of victories in challenge matches, confidence began to return. Diligent preparation for this game is essential and with a large squad of 26 players vying for 15 places it will give myself and my selectors Michael Bonner and John Mc Monagle plenty headaches in the coming days.



I think today's final will be a thriller. Our team have a good blend of youth and experience, with an average age of 22. Naomh Brid are hungry for success and it



building a good future for our young players breaking through to senior level.


