Classy Corkery returns to Cork fold to boost Tompkins' hand

Match report from last meeting 22nd March 2003. CORK 3-8 DONEGAL 0-10

LARRY TOMPKINS' Rebels protected their unbeaten record on home turf when for the third time in this year's Allianz Football League Division IA they emerged victorious at Páirc Uí Rinn on Saturday night under floodlights.

Kerry and Galway had already fallen at the splendid former Flower Lodge venue and Cork played some excellent controlled football after weathering an early Donegal onslaught to collect both league points. Cork were well worth their seven point victory at the finish and were also boosted by the return of Colin Corkery following his All-Ireland Club winning heroics with Nemo Rangers on St Patrick's Day.

The Rebels resumed the second half with Derek Kavanagh in for the injured Eoin Sexton. The Nemo Rangers' man partnered Nicholas Murphy at midfield, with Graham Canty dropping back to the pivotal position. Donegal lost the chance of a goal minutes into the second half, when the ball broke to the unmarked Brendan Devanney, but he was denied by an excellent save by Cork goalkeeper Kevin O'Dwyer. From there on things got worse for Donegal and when Jim O'Donoghue was pulled back going through, Brendan Jer O'Sullivan slotted home the resultant penalty, sending goalkeeper Gerry McGill the wrong way.

Cork tightened their grip further with an O'Sullivan point and they were three clear goals after 47 minutes.

Tompkins introduced three members of the victorious Nemo team - Corkery, Alan Cronin and Maurice McCarthy - to the delight of the home crowd, and it took Corkery 10 minutes to get on the scoresheet.

When he finally did manage to score it was worth the wait as he pointed superbly from out near the touchline, a score reminiscent of the winning-point he scored in All-Ireland Club decider victory over Crossmolina. Cork remained firmly in control for the remainder of the match and it was fitting that Corkery should have the final say when he punched James O'Shea's cross to the net to prove, if proof was needed, just how valuable a forward he is to the Cork attack.
