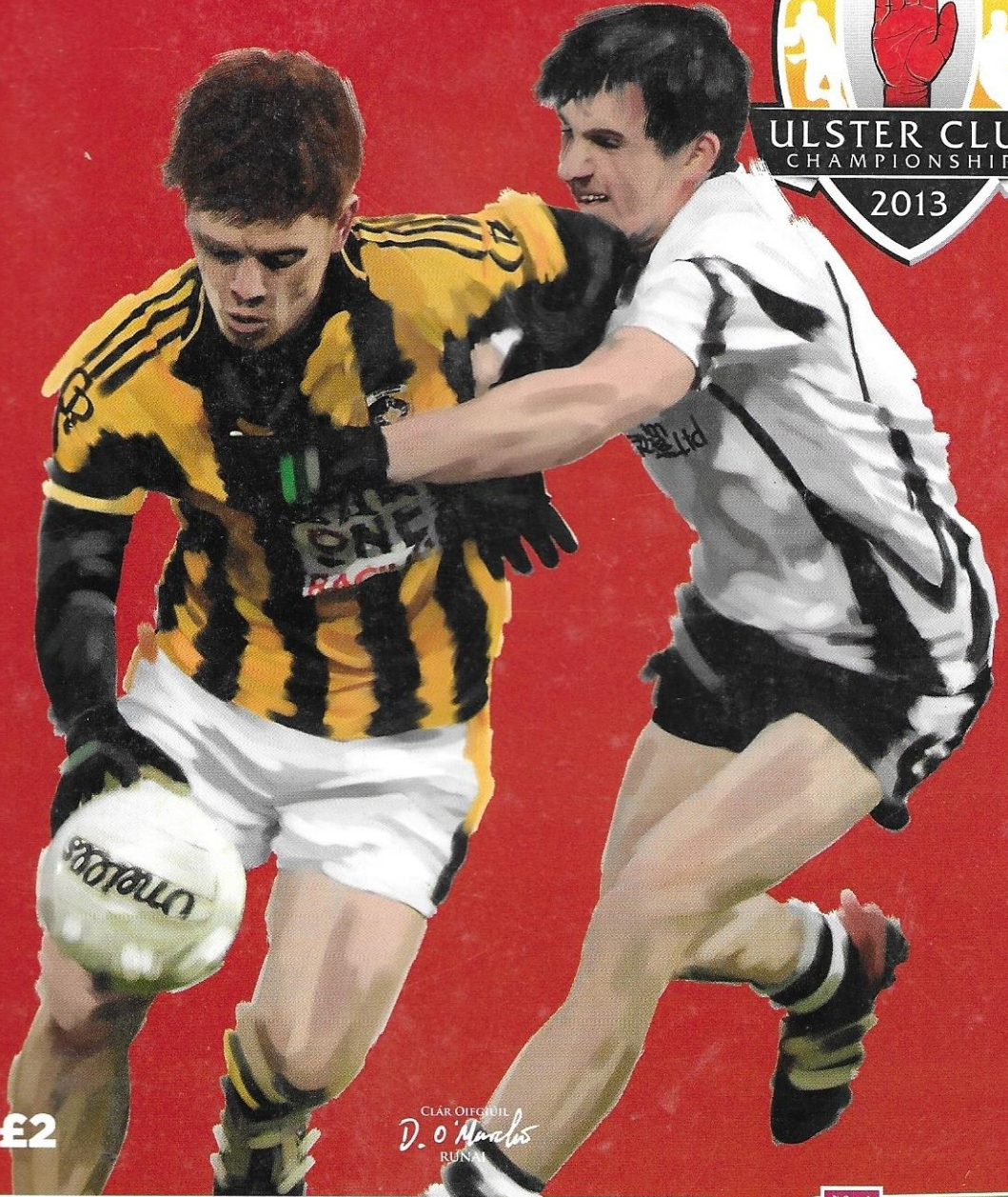
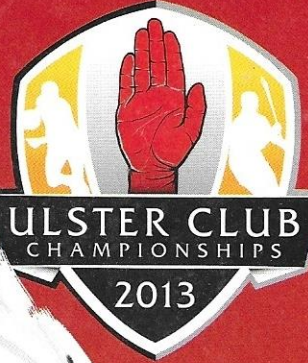

My thanks to our county grounds for hosting today's games, our facilities for players and patrons are of a high standard and I thank all stewards, field officials and event controllers.

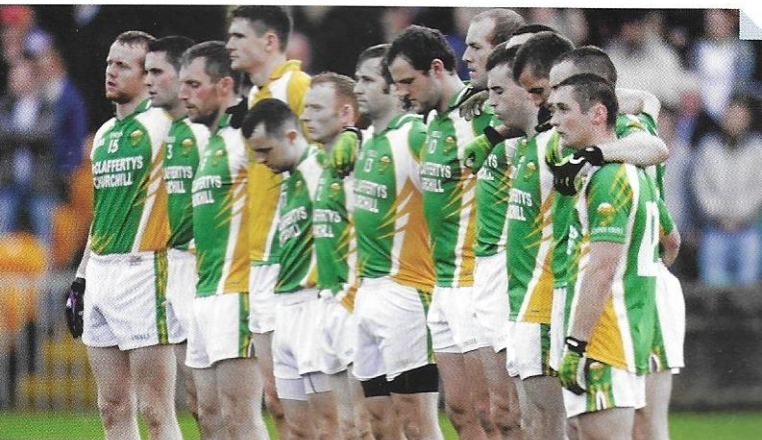

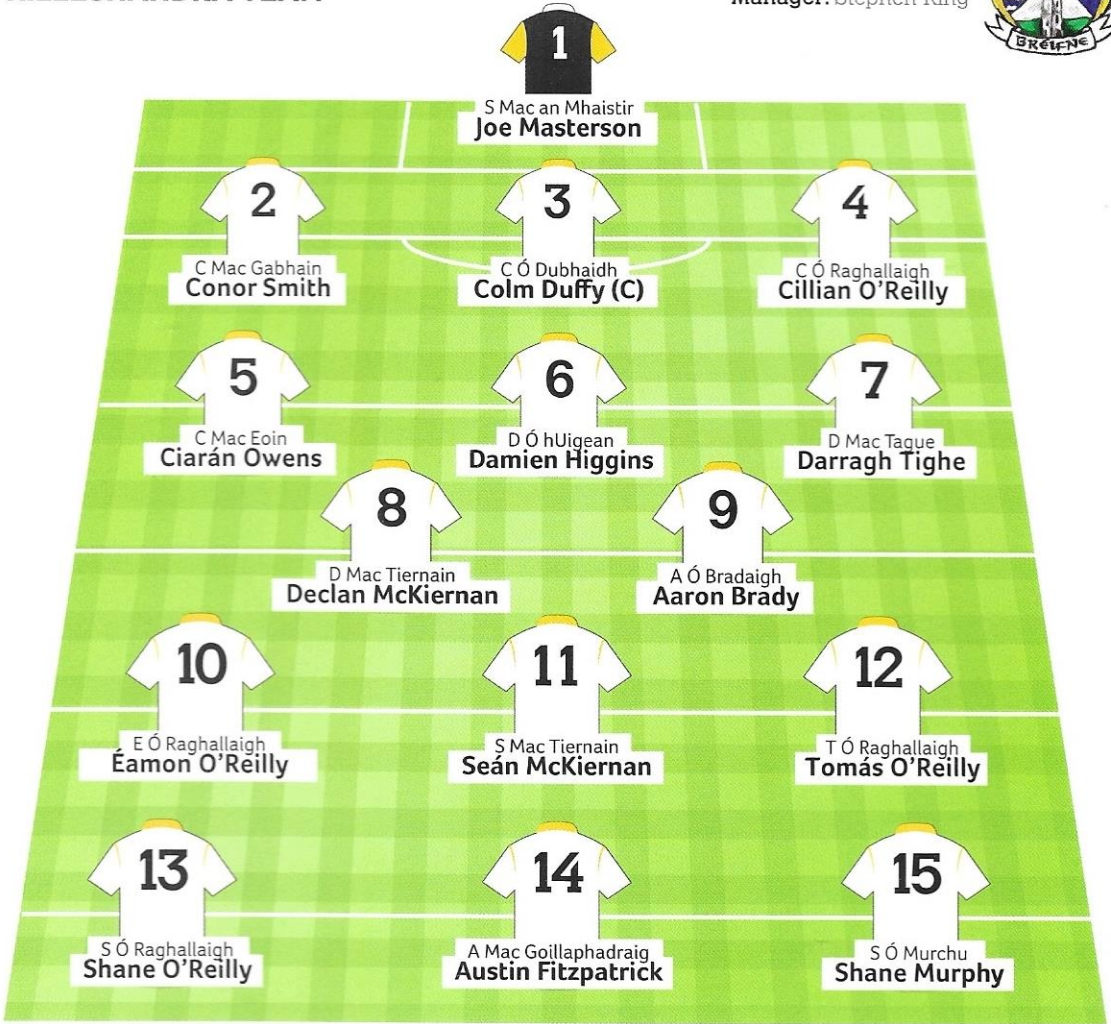

Opportunities to enhance employability Skills

Open College Network Accredited Courses

Level 3 Team Management and L3 Performance Coaching programmes commencing January. Mirror your preparation for the season through our bespoke GAA courses. These are designed to give you recognition for the hours that you put into your teams preparation. It also develops transferable and employability skills to enhance your CV.

Long Term Unemployed

Programmes are currently running to target unemployed and engage them in developing their employability skills and experience. Ulster will be rolling out opportunities to take coaching awards in Football, Hurling, Handball, Camogie and Ladies Football in a two week block. Coaches are then encouraged to engage with a club or school to develop their

work experience. At the moment young people (18-24) who are on Job Seekers can access a period of work experience to add value to the training. The programme can be accessed through your local jobs and benefits offices. This support is free to all participants.

2014 O'Neills Ulster GAA Coaching Conference

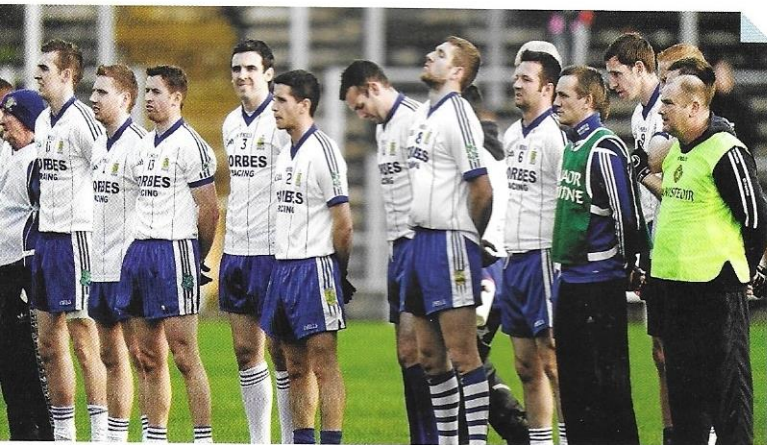

The event is focused on coaching football and hurling and speakers from Dublin will explore the different models for development that have been tried and tested to bring success in the club and in the county.

Coach Development Programme to include 15+ Warm-up Workshops

THE WORK OF ULSTER GAA



Where does the money go?

Ulster GAA is the governing body of the GAA in Ulster. The Ulster GAA Council comprises its officers elected at the annual Ulster Convention; two delegates elected from each of the Province's nine Counties; and a delegate from each of the educational bodies. Ulster GAA works across two

political jurisdictions and 29 local authorities. It is also 'twinned' with the GAA units in both Britain and Canada and carries out significant development work in both in this regard.

All members of the Ulster Council are volunteers. They

drive change; lead in decision making and are responsible for planning for the future. The Council's decisions and plans are implemented by Ulster GAA Staff who are accountable to the Provincial Director and the Council's Management Committee.

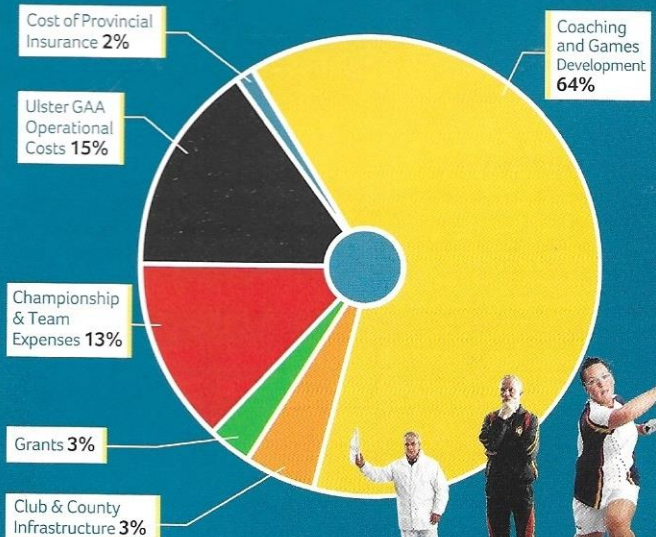
83% of Ulster GAA income is reinvested in Counties, Clubs and Communities

Year-on-year Ulster GAA reinvests 83% of its income in Clubs and Counties.

It does this by providing direct support in Coaching and Games Development; Club Development and Capacity Building and Governance and Strategic Development. It also provides advice and guidance in infrastructure and grant and other funding. Crucially, it awards cash grants for infrastructure developments. This combination of support makes the GAA unique and something we are very proud of.

We believe that no other organisation re-invests this level of revenue or makes the telling social and economic contribution to life of the island that the GAA does.
