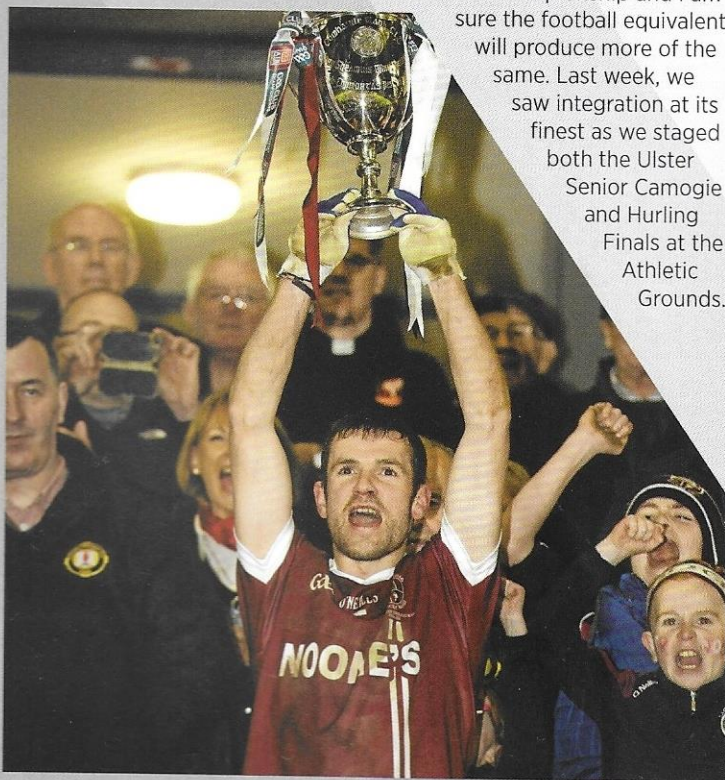

"I wish Gaeilge sa Chlub Scholars every success and happiness as they embark in their learning journey with the Ulster University."

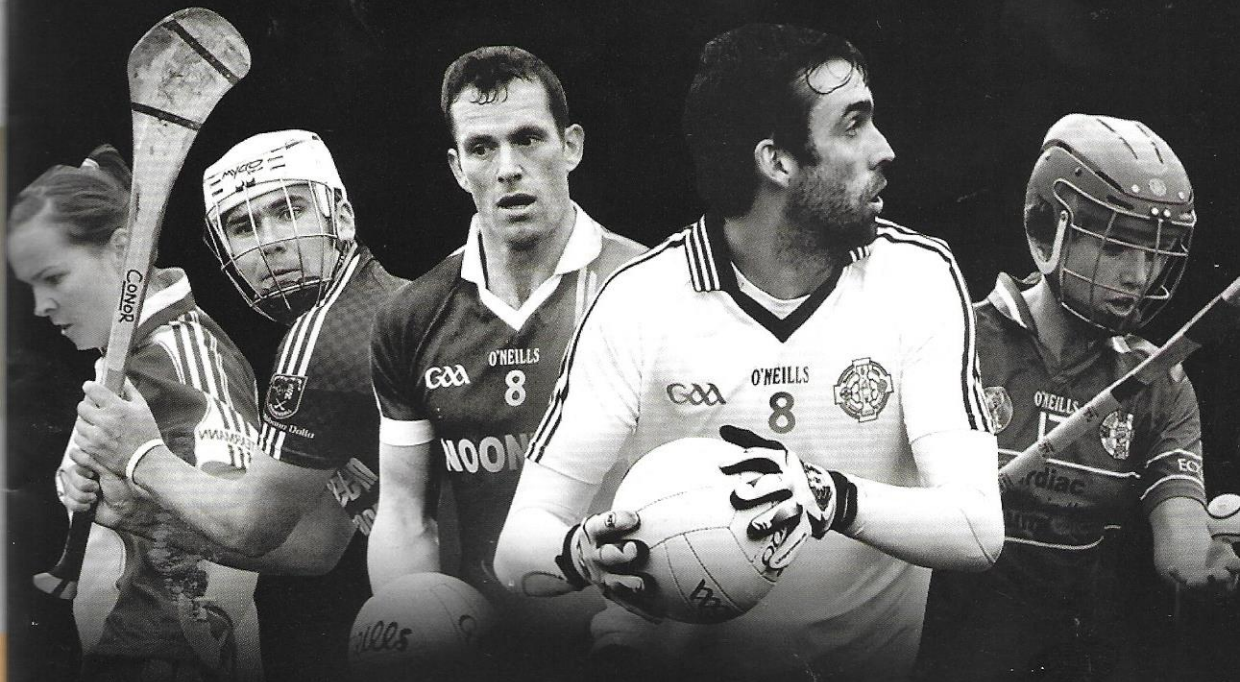

SPORTS INJURIES, CONCUSSION AND THE LAW



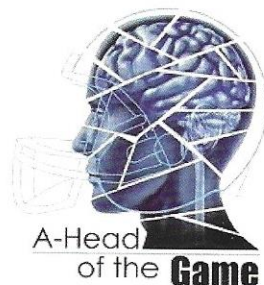
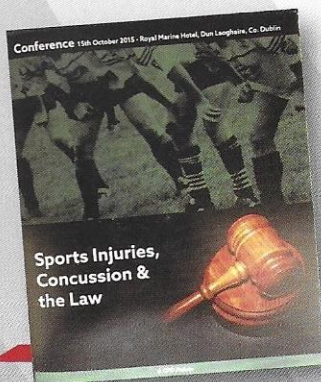
At the recent Conference on Sports Injuries, Concussion and the Law issues such as the identification and management of concussion, education about drugs and anti-doping procedures and the legal issues around players and coaches betting on games were all debated.

Clinical psychologist Elaine Kelly with Headway Ireland emphasised the coaches' responsibility to know and implementing the concussion protocols especially where medical assistance is not available. The adherence to return to play protocols outlined by the Association need to be implemented and parents, partners, teachers and coaches with other sports notified that the individual has had a head injury.

Professor John Ryan team doctor with Leinster Rugby and Consultant in Emergency Medicine reinforced these messages. He flagged up the lack of reporting in community sport and the weekend warrior with the head injury not being dealt with correctly. Headgear doesn't protect as a hit even lower down on the body can cause a concussion. He advocated a uniform approach by all sports to concussion management recommending the SCAT3 protocols. The use of a white card issued to the player following a concussion incident was discussed and how this can be used to inform others of the incident. The need to embed education in coaching, with parents and in player development programmes was deemed essential.

Tim O'Connor BL is a practicing barrister and has been involved in litigation in sports law in Ireland. There was a clear message that coaches need to implement the rules set out by the association in relation to concussion management protocols. He stressed the need for education in the symptoms, signs and return to play protocols. The need for a cultural change, an education programme and the need to recognise, remove and rest players. A player who tears a hamstring is removed immediately and rested, go through fitness test before return to play. The fact that we often cannot see a head injury makes it no less important and requires the same attention. Individuals who are not club members but play on a team also offer a challenge as in the past they have taken out litigation against the club following injuries.

Gary Rice a solicitor spoke about the challenges of anti-doping and betting. He highlighted that everything that we hold dear in society is crystallised in sport. He suggested that sports law strives to secure and preserve the uncertainty of the outcome. In this way the need to tackle drugs and game fixing in sport in central to the survival of that uncertainty.



So what are the take away messages for us as coaches, parents and administrators and how we can at Ulster GAA help:

- **Concussion Awareness** – run a workshop in your club with our help
- **Concussion Protocols** – issue the white card when someone has suspected head injury
- **Inform** parents, partners, other sports coaches, schools with a call
- **Adhere** to the return to play protocols
- **Drugs** – keep a close eye on players and discourage their use of supplements.
- **Player Lifestyle**

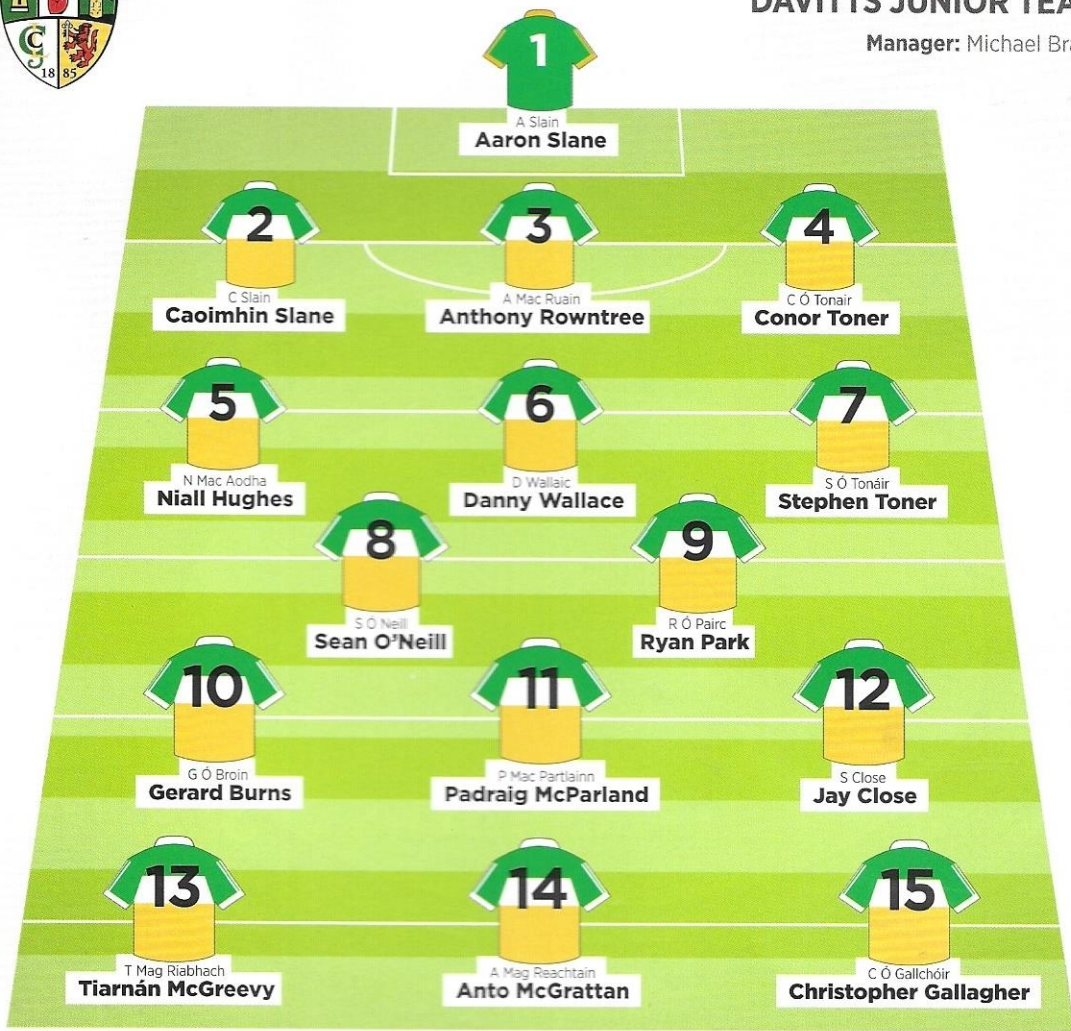

The Officers on duty reserve the right to remove you from the ground if you do not comply with these simple regulations. Our intention is simply to ensure that all our supporters can enjoy the match.

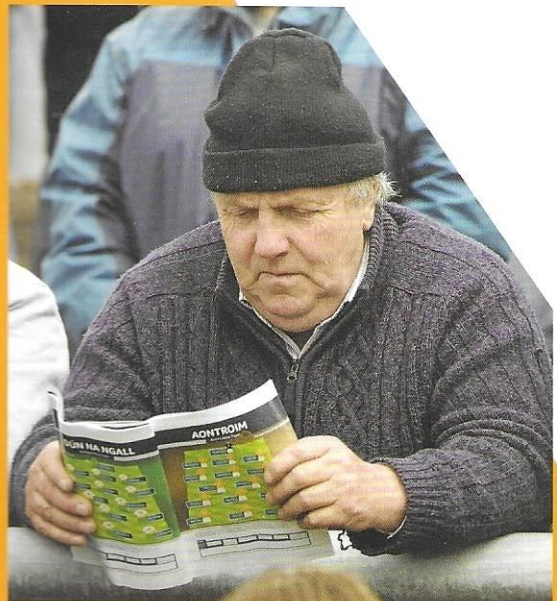
