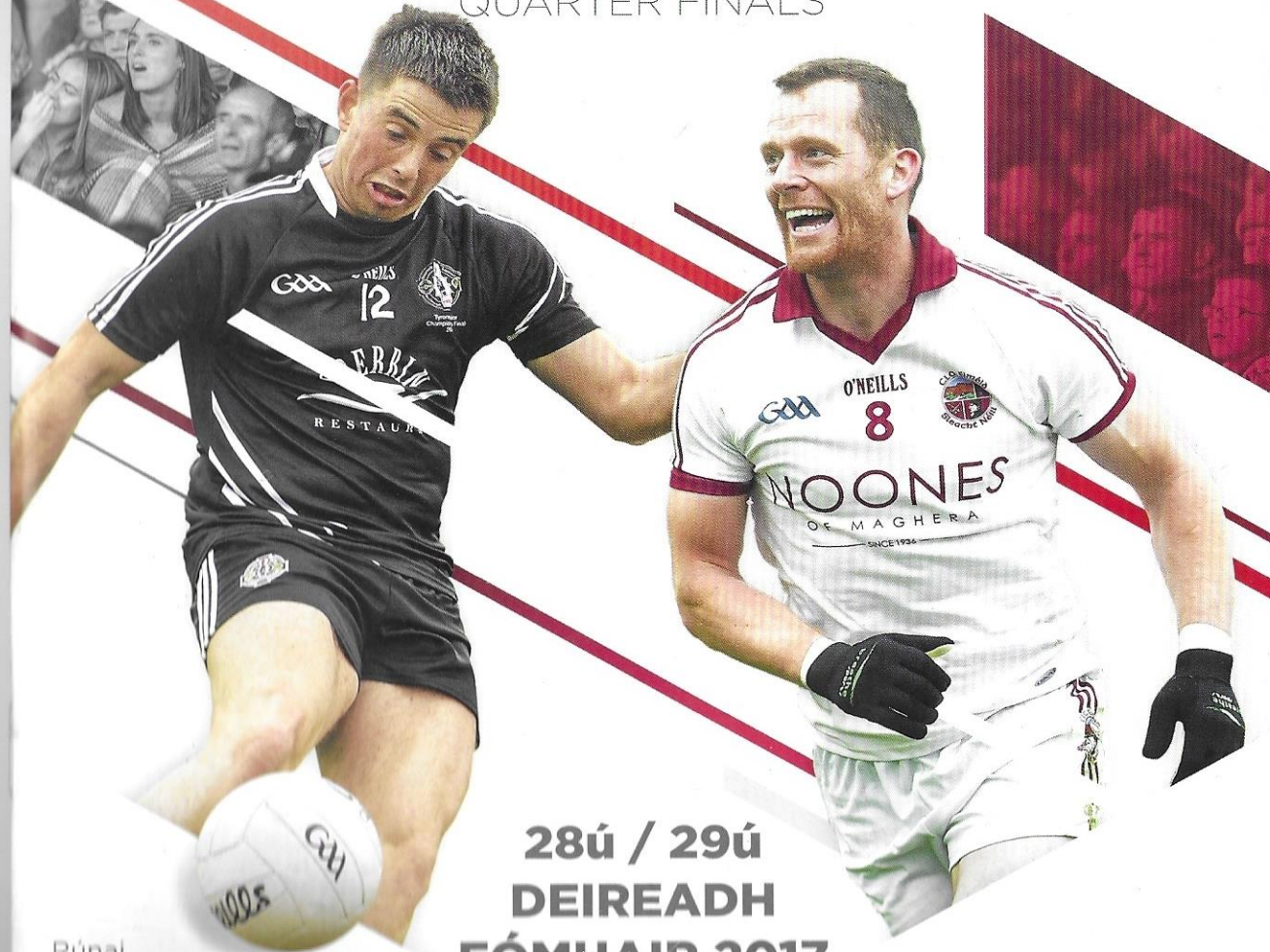

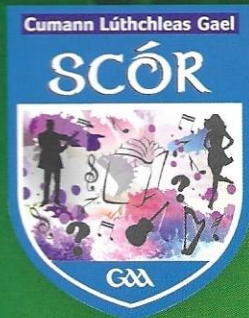

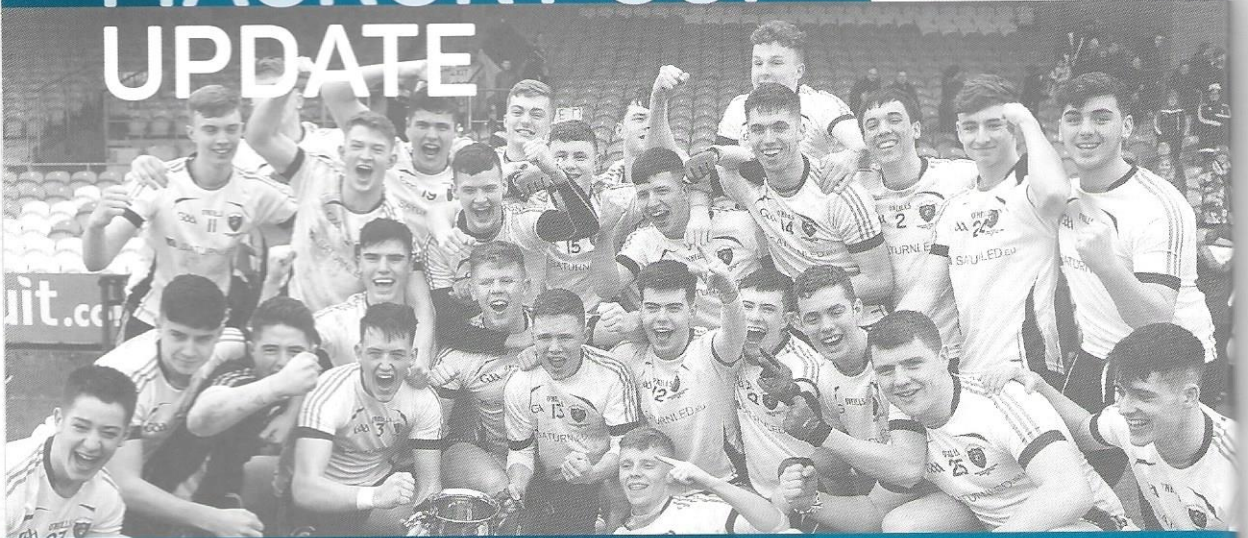

MACRORY CUP UPDATE



With 29 goals in seven games to date, the 2017/18 Danske Bank MacRory Cup has produced a blistering start for all concerned. This year's competition promises to be one of the most open in a long time, with a record 16 teams challenging for the top prize in Ulster Schools football.

There was an entertaining start as Omagh CBS and newcomers St Malachy's Castlewellan played out a high scoring draw in the first game. Trailing by seven points at the break, the Down side fought back to lead by three points as the game entered injury time, but Omagh refused to lie down and kicked three unanswered points to claim a share of the points.

Defending champions St Mary's Magherafelt opened the defence of their title with a win over Patrician Carrickmacross. A lightning fast start done the damage for St Mary's, racing into a 1-5 to 0-1 lead midway through the first half. They would go on to fire home four goals, two from Adam Connolly, in an impressive display.

St Patrick's Cavan also started strongly against their Dungannon namesakes in their encounter in Scotstown. Thomas Smith

bagged two goals in the opening 13 minutes to help the Cavan side to a nine point half time cushion. Amazingly, Dungannon battled back to trail by a single point with ten minutes to go, but Cavan kicked for home again and ran out eight point winners.

There was further late drama in the game between Abbey CBS and St Ciaran's Ballygawley, where an injury time goal from Lorcan Forde, his second of the game, snatched victory for the Newry side. Ballygawley had looked set to open their account with victory, Darragh Canavan leading the way with 1-6, as the Tyrone side come from behind to lead by two as the game entered injury time before the late drama.

It was raining goals in Garvaghey as an Armagh derby between St Patrick's Armagh and St Ronan's Lurgan produced a pulsating game, the sides sharing six goals between them. Tiarnan Kelly goaled twice in the opening half for St Ronan's but it wasn't until the final quarter that they managed to put daylight between the sides, despite Seamus Muldoon keeping St Patrick's in touch with two goals of his own. Another Armagh side who recorded a win in the opening round was

St Paul's Bessbrook after they overcame St Michael's Enniskillen by the minimum. An Oran Kearns free kick four minutes from time edged St Paul's ahead moments after a Ryan Connolly goal had brought them back into the game. St Michael's had led when a long range free from Ronan Beattie was misjudged and ended in the net.

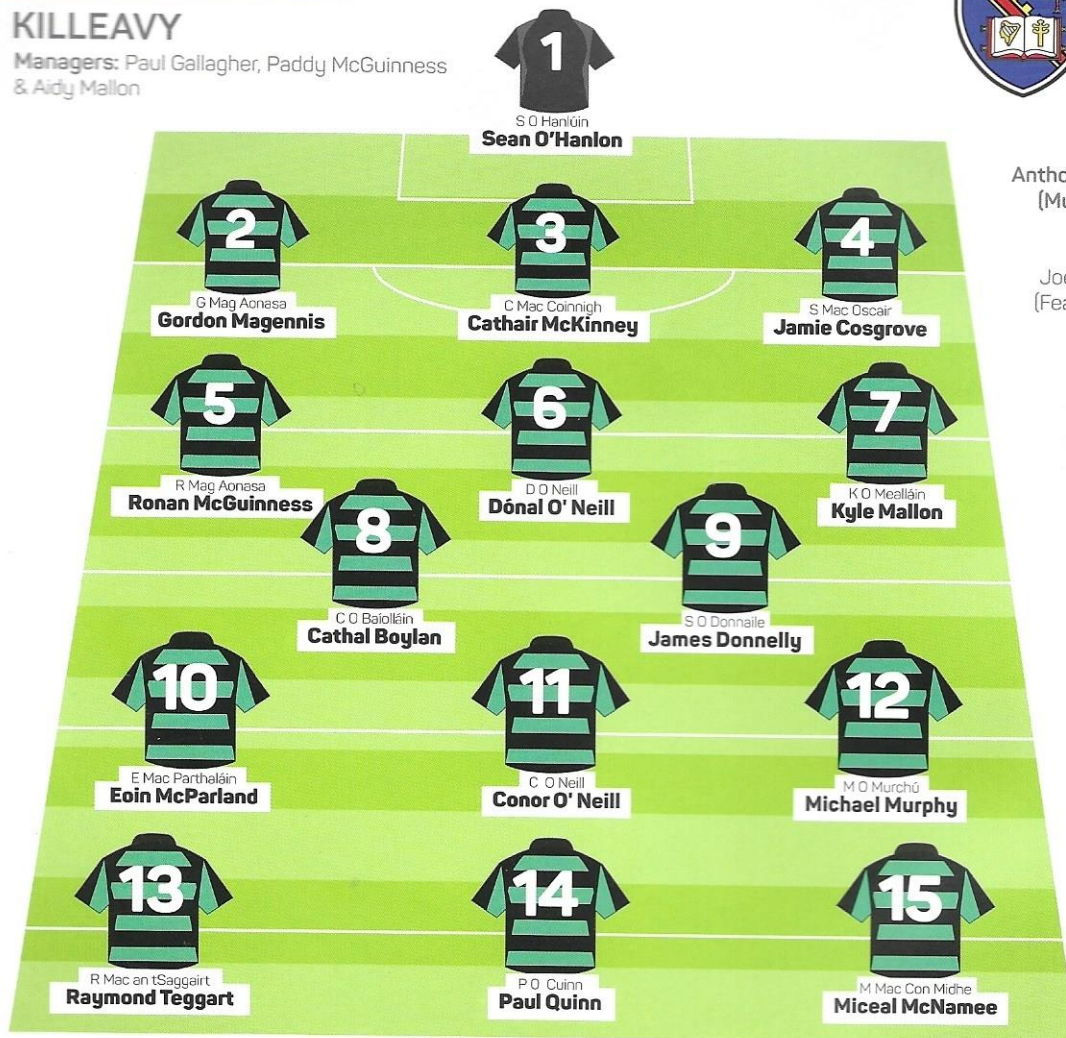

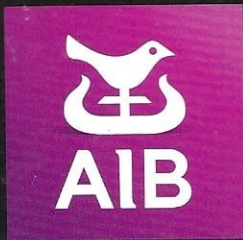
