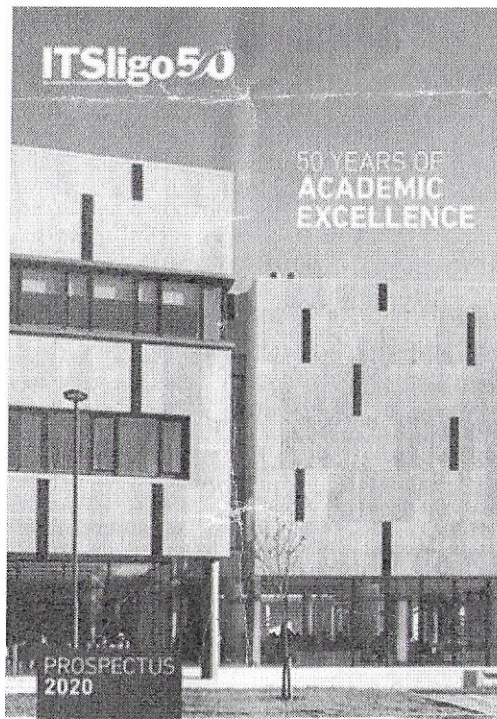

# Powerful performance by Letterkenny IT

Letterkenny IT booked their place in the Sigerson Cup semi-finals following an impressive win over IT Sligo in Sligo on Sunday.

The Michael Murphy managed side (which comprised fully of players from Donegal) had the game in a tight grip at half-time as they led 1-9 to 1-4.

In the second half Letterkenny IT kept IT Sligo at bay, with the Sligo men also finishing the game with 13 players with two late red cards.

Letterkenny IT were four points up after just 12 minutes, thanks to two Peadar Mogan frees and fine points from Eoghan McGettigan and Michael Langan, after a great break from defence when Mark McAteer forced a turnover, something that was a feature of the half.

Cillian McGloin got Sligo's first point after 13 minutes, after Cormac Murray missed a great opportunity minutes earlier from a 20m free.

After that Donegal gained the kick-out, it was fed into Michael Langan and he went

straight through and fired to the net from 20 metres for the Letterkenny IT side.

It was 1-4 to a point on 14 minutes but McGloin pulled a point back a minute later for IT Sligo.

Letterkenny's first goal could easily have been followed up by a second, again from Langan who passed to Darragh Black, but he blasted over the bar from close range.

Another Peadar Mogan point on 18 mins saw Letterkenny IT extend their lead 1-6 to 0-2.

This seemed to rally IT Sligo. It started with a Sean Carrabine point from play,

with a goal on 22 mins when Nathan Boyle's effort was initially blocked by the Donegal net minder Michael Lynch but Sligo's Tiernan McSkean followed up to bundle the ball into the net. Two more Letterkenny points from Darragh Black and Eoghan McGettigan saw them pull back two of the three points lost through the Sligo goal.

Carrabine for Sligo and another Black point from Letterkenny saw an interval lead of five points for Letterkenny IT 1-9 to 1-4.

It took seven minutes of the second half before Peadar Mogan set up Eoghan

McGettigan for the first score of the second half. Sean Carrabine replied from a free before Michael Langan and Carrabine traded frees by the 43rd minute.

IT Sligo had their best period in the middle of the second half with Michael Lynch making a couple of great saves, twice denying Cormac Murray.

Donegal introduced big John Campbell and he made an immediate impact, firing over and McGettigan won and pointed a free to stretch the lead to 1-13 to 1-6 with eight minutes left.

IT Sligo threw everything at Letterkenny but all they

could muster was points from Lee Jones and Carrabine from a free. Liam Jackson had LYIT's final score and in the final minutes Sligo lost their discipline with Lee Jones and Luke Molloy both seeing red for reacting.
